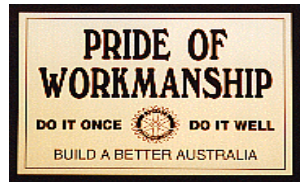


The Rotary Club of Strathfield - Pride of Workmanship awards

What is “Pride of Workmanship”?

Pride of Workmanship is an award The Rotary Club of Strathfield presents annually to people in our community who have been nominated by a Rotarian, a community organisation, an employer, a fellow employee, or a member of the public: who in their opinion exhibits the qualities of leadership, dedication to their profession or job, or is someone who provides excellent service or is just consistently good in their job, or perhaps a person who has assisted members of the public or fellow employees who may be ill or in some form of distress.

There are many possibilities for nomination of this award: *an awardee might be a nurse or doctor, a worker in aged care, a bus driver or a mechanic, a teacher or early childhood educator, the local post office worker, a salesperson or bank teller.*

Does someone you know fit these criteria?

Nominations are now open, but they must close on Wednesday **November 1st**. A nomination form can be downloaded from our web page <http://www.strathfieldrotary.org.au/>

What is needed to nominate?

- The Rotary Club needs need a name and contact number for the nominee and nominator
- **The nominee’s position or role in an organisation, and the name of the employer.**
- **The Rotary Club needs a “brief” citation of what the nominee does and why they deserve the award.** The citation should be sincere, to the point and NOT more than 200 words.

What does the nominee receive?

- **An inscribed Rotary “Pride of Workmanship” plaque.**
- An invitation to dinner on the awards night as a guest of Strathfield Rotary. Friends and family members are all welcome. However persons accompanying you pay for their dinner.
- The nominee judged by the Vocational Service Committee to most exemplify the principles of **“Pride of Workmanship” will be presented with the prestigious “Ray Sherry” shield**

Guidelines

What is 'Pride of Workmanship'?

Pride of Workmanship is an award the Rotary Club of Strathfield presents annually to people in our community who have been nominated by a Rotarian, a community organisation, an employer, a fellow employee, or a member of the public: who in their opinion exhibits the qualities of leadership, dedication to their profession or job, or who provides excellent service or is just consistently good in what they do, or perhaps a person who has assisted fellow employees or members of the public in distress.

The primary objective of the award is to recognize and encourage vocational excellence, with particular regard to productivity, quality, responsibility, creativity, initiative & ethics.

These awards provide employers with the opportunity, through Rotary of recognizing and acknowledging the efforts and contributions of employees who are dedicated to their vocation and consistently achieve exceptional standards.

These awards consistent with its emphasis on the commitment to a job or vocation, well done by the person, has as its theme "*Do it once, Do it well, Build a Better Australia*"

The Pride of Workmanship Award is not a competition and there are no *winners* in the strict sense of the word. It is expected that normally there will be only one *awardee* from one organization - the most deserving person.

It is also important and perhaps essential that the award recipient is seen as being worthy in the eyes of his/her peers, family and community.

Pride of Workmanship, as a Rotary sponsored award, has been widely acclaimed and adopted throughout Australia and is now finding increasing acceptance throughout the world.

The Award is formulated with the intention of encouraging favorable employer - peer - employee relationships and a sense of community pride in these individual achievements.

It is desirable that the *awardee* either works or lives in Strathfield or vicinity of Strathfield.

The Awards are to be presented at a Pride of Workmanship Awards Presentation Evening, to which the other members of the *awardee's* organization, business or family are invited as paying guests. The *awardee* is a guest of our club.
