President Ray and Darren presented Alexander Bussing-Todd with a Special Award from the Strathfield Rotary Club for his outstanding service to the Strathfield SES. Alex has been an SES volunteer for 10 years and has put-in a 100% effort in many operations locally, in the Blue Mountains and in Western Sydney. Darren then handed over to his Deputy-Controller, Joanne, who gave us some statistics about the SES.

There are 40,000 volunteers across Australia in the SES with 11,000 based in NSW. This Wednesday was *WOW, Wear Orange Wednesday,* with all encouraged to wear something ORANGE. Joanne presented a slide show of pictures taken at operations over the last 12 months. Most notable was the flooding across NSW that affected 20,000 people.

Many of the volunteers were asked to give their reason for joining the Strathfield SES.

- Alex joined to be with people he knew.
- **Janette** joined for the ongoing commitment of like-minded people.
- **Joanne** joined as soon as she was 18 years old to build self-confidence.
- Catherine joined soon after the Thredbo Landslide.
- John was from country NSW and had seen the SES in action during the many outback floods, so joined for a break from officework and to build self-confidence.

- Allan joined to support his son, Darren.
- **Ryan** was the youngest member and joined because he liked the people.

President Ray thanked all the SES volunteers on behalf of the Club and of the Community generally. President Ray assured them that the Club would be thinking of them when the distribution of Club Funds takes place next year.
