Strathfield Rotary & New District -"Looking Forward – Looking Back"

Last Week's Meeting: Guest Speaker David Rosenberg "Inside Pine Gap"

David spoke to us about his career with the United States National Security Agency (NSA) which he joined in 1990. He spent 4 years working in Washington and then a further 18 years as an analyst at Pine Gap, 22 kilometres from Alice Springs in the Northern Territory.

Some of the areas he spoke about included;

- What is Pine Gap?
- When, why and how it was established.
- Why in Alice Springs.
- What might Pine Gap look for?

The facility is a joint operation between USA and Australia with approximately 160 operations staff of which approximately 60% are from the US.

David's presentation was professionally delivered and it was fascinating listen to his experiences.

David was introduced by Allan Teale and thanked by Past President Peter Smith.

As Rotary celebrates its'108th anniversary, gains against polio continue.

Rotary's 108th anniversary on 23 February marked a year of both achievements in the fight to eradicate polio and a stepped-up commitment to finish the job.

Worldwide, 222 polio cases were reported in 2012, a little more than one-third of the 650 cases reported in 2011. India marked its second year without polio on 13 January. Overall, the annual incidence of polio has decreased more than 99 percent since the Global Polio Eradication Initiative was launched in 1988. Then polio infected about 350,000 children per year.

District Golf Day

It was disappointing that from the whole of District 9690 only 18 Golfers turned out to play in the annual District Golf Day. All happened to be from Strathfield Rotary club, therefore as a result, Strathfield reclaimed the "Shield". Despite the wet and windy conditions everyone involved had a good day.
