

Last Week

Andrew Tink, author, was introduced by PP Peter Smith and the vote of thanks on behalf of members and guests was provided by PE Allan Teale.

Andrew talked about a plane crash which took place on approach to Canberra Airport in August 1940 that destroyed a Government. The fatal disaster took place when a recently imported Lockheed Hudson bomber crashed on its approach to the aerodrome, killing all on board. Among the passengers were three cabinet ministers in the Menzies government: James Fairbairn, Geoffrey Street and Henry Gullett.

Andrew has written about the circumstances surrounding the disaster in a book "Air Disaster Canberra" which was published in April 2013.
