Streetlevel is in an urban setting in Sydney's Surry Hills. You are on the frontline of mission in the city. Faced with issues of homelessness, addiction, high density living and everything in between. Streetlevel is a community where people can come, be who they are and find acceptance and inclusion in the city. Streetlevel has a number of programs and opportunities that you will have access to. You will receive support from the Streetlevel team and connect with the leaders on a regular basis.

We emphasise a holistic approach to social and personal development, by caring for the physical, emotional and spiritual needs of those who live a shared life in this community.

Students become a part of Streetlevel through their time spent in our community centre, faith based activities, church and community programs/outings. Students are rostered into the Streetlevel program as well as having the opportunity to get involved with one off activities or community events.
