Lynne also told us about the Australian PlantBank which is a science and research facility of the Royal Botanic Gardens and Domain Trust and is located at the Australian Botanic Garden, Mount Annan. It houses the Trust's seedbank and research laboratories that specialise in horticultural research and

conservation of Australian native plant species, particularly those from New South Wales.

Lynne has "planted a seed" and left us in no doubt that we all need and should visit the 3 garden locations.

Lynne was introduced by Keith Byrn and thanked by Bradley Ayres.
