#### President Petersen's Page

At last week's Wednesday night Club meeting we welcomed, Maria Moran, District 9675 ROMAC Chair and Mr Ron Delezio, the Rotary Eastern Zone ROMAC Chair. Our Club has not been regularly connected with ROMAC (Rotary Oceanic Medical Aid for Children) and after listening to Ron outline a heartfelt horrific accident that affected his daughter Sophie and family some twelve years ago we were all moved to apply our efforts to provide greater support to such a worthy cause. ROMAC originated when a Rotarian, visiting Fiji in 2008, came across a Fijian teenager who required immediate surgery to save her leg. Ron's family tragedy pinpointed the question: What would you do if your child needed immediate medical provision?

Over the intervening years an increasing number of Rotary Clubs has become involved and children have been flown to Australia for major, often life saving surgery ROMAC is now proudly a Rotary International approved multi district program of Australia and New Zealand.

At the initiative of Rotarian International Director a cheque for \$500 was presented to Ron on the night.

## Rotary International Council of Legislation

Every four years RI meets to determine the relevance of the legislation by which Clubs order Rotary business. At the District Presidents' Meeting last Friday, PDG Bill Slater the 9675 District Representative at the forthcoming April RI Council indicated that 166 pieces of legislation of the Manual of Procedures would be considered and the subsequent outcome would be in place for implementation by Clubs from 1 July, 2016. This has implications for the Boards of the 2016-2017 Rotary Club and in our case for the leadership being provided by PE Stephen Taylor

Our Rotary Constitution was accepted by a Special Resolution on 15th November, 2011 and Part A of that document, following advice provided at the Presidents' Meeting could require modification in accordance with whatever are the outcomes reached by the Council: Article 3: Locality of the Club-probable no specific boundaries, Article 6: Meetings: when? How often held? Type? Article 7: Membership: Rotaracters could become full-time Rotarians, Article 8: Classification: Item 16.21, Article 9: Attendance: Should there be any limitations?

Generally, it was indicated that:

- There would be an increase in RI Semi Annual Dues of 50cents per half year for the next three years
- · The Directorate of Youth Service would be rebadged as New Generations.

**Bowelcare 2016** 

Bowelcare is a Government program which targets persons aged 65+ for five yearly screenings.

Our Club has provided a service for ten pharmacies in the past to distribute the kits and some time later collect returned products for examination by qualified researchers. PP Director Peter Smith has taken charge for this year during May and June for distribution and collection.

Results reported show that in 2014 two Rotary Districts, of which ours is one that 33 452 kits were distributed: 12 cases revealed that carcinomas were present, 35 cases revealed that polyps were present, 145 cases results remain pending. Therefore, some 33 252 participants can rest assured that their involvement was to their advantage
