We welcome tonight on this celebration of the 111th Anniversary of the foundation of Rotary by Paul Harris in Chicago on the 23rd February, 1905 Stephen Humphreys, incoming District Governor of District 9675. Stephen is accompanied by his wife Judith both of whom are sharing this momentous occasion with us.

Stephen has always had a keen involvement in the community and has held committee positions, including president, on the parent bodies of his children's schools for around 20 years. He was a very keen golfer and has been the President of Camden Golf Club for the past 14 years.

Married to Judith for 42 years they have three children Robert, Fiona and Andrew as well as four beautiful grandsons. Stephen and Judith have lived in the Macarthur area for most of their married life.

So the emotion of happiness and the attitude of positivity also brings the wonder of hope with it along for the ride. And to this day, it's those three emotions that guide my life.

So I am well aware that the word cancer can strike fear into our hearts because everybody has been touched by it, whether you've had a diagnosis yourself or somebody close to you has. Breakthroughs are coming every day, but it's only through fundraising that we can continue this vital work. I'm happy to make a positive difference by entering a team in the SYDNEY RELAY FOR LIFE for the last two years and raised over \$14 000 for the Cancer Council. Last year's Relay for Life around Australia collectively raised over \$23 million."

RELAY FOR LIFE is not a running race. We walk around a track for 24 hours because cancer never sleeps. It's a way to celebrate survivors and their carers to those we've lost along the way and to raise funds to fight back and find a cure.
