Speaker for this week: Craig Wood

Craig Wood has been part of Destiny Rescue for over 8 years. He has worked in several overseas countries, overseeing building projects in Rescue homes and on the field doing Reconnaissance Operations. He has gone undercover into some of the most notorious red light districts in South East Asia in search of children being trafficked. Craig's main focus, is to bring awareness about one of the fastest growing criminal enterprises in our world today and raise support to end child trafficking.

Destiny Rescue is an Australian based antichild trafficking organisation and so far have rescued just over 6000 individuals from sexual trafficking from 8 different nations. We work alongside the FBI, National Bureau of investigation, Australian Federal Police, British intelligence and local law enforcements.
