Meeting held 22 February, 2023



The guest speaker last week was **Matthew Siely**, co-owner of Sydney Beer Co. located in Surry Hills. Sydney Beer is part of the food and beverage industry and for the past seven years Matt has been writing about the Sydney beer scene and the people involved in the craft beer industry.

Club members... you needed to be there to sample the beer that Matt brought with him. By all accounts it was a pleasant drop. (The Bulletin writer did not try as was too busy taking notes for said Bulletin.)

The brewery is located in Goulburn using a recipe developed by Matt and his business partner. The beer is produced using local ingredients. It is preservative free and vegan friendly. The fermentation process takes three weeks compared with just a few days for the larger brands. This is a beer that most people can drink - a style that is suitable for weddings and functions. It is a clean beer that works well followed by wine. Matt talked about the importance of intellectual property and having IP organized at the outset, ensuring that the words Sydney and Beer are protected. Corporate governance is another major part of the business as is having a Board. Labelling and marketing were discussed; along with the issues in marketing internationally. China being one market already established and the current journey to capture the Indian market. Shortly there will be a zero alcohol to suit the Middle East market.
