Past District Governor Jeremy Wright joined the meeting with a message about the "Windeward Bound" tall ship. Jeremy was also the guest speaker as he and President Andrew Aravanis shared an "in conversation" session.



The conversation covered Jeremys' career at ICI and Kodak, then his journey into medical research. This involved many areas, including the introduction of the Red Nose Day in NSW in 1989. Then on to research into Multiple Sclerosis and being a Board member of Trish MS the Research Foundation.

PDG Jeremy Wright was awarded an AM (Member of the Order) in the Queen's Birthday Honours List for his significant services to the not-for-profit sector.

Jeremy also talked about his three decades of beekeeping and entertained all with his knowledge of bees.

The vessel is arriving in Sydney 26 April and staying for two weeks. It will be berthed at the Maritime Museum. PDG Jeremy said this is a great youth development opportunity for 14-17 year olds (plus older). They will be recruited/sponsored for this experiential 5-7 day voyage to Brisbane.
