A message from **Past District Governor David Croft** concerning the **Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA)**

The District 9675 RYLA committee has advised that the 2023 RYLA program is going ahead from the 3rd-8th of January, 2023 at Stanwell Tops. Strathfield Rotary Club proposes to support up to four attendees at RYLA.

For the benefit of our newer members, the Rotary Youth Leadership Awards or "RYLA" is a life-changing leadership program for young adults aged around 19 to 25. The committee has advised that they will consider applications from 18 year olds.

The 7-day program typically has 75 participants and focuses on leadership, personal development, teamwork and community awareness.

RYLA gives young people the chance to build their communication and problem-solving skills. They will learn from community leaders, peer mentors, special guest speakers and Rotarians. This is both a challenging and rewarding program.

RYLA features presentations from many experts who generously donate their time and experience to further the development of young leaders. The program combines workshops and presentations to fully explore the fundamentals of effective leadership.

Awardees will form amazing connections with their fellow participants, and the impact on their lives will go well-beyond the 7 days they spend together.
