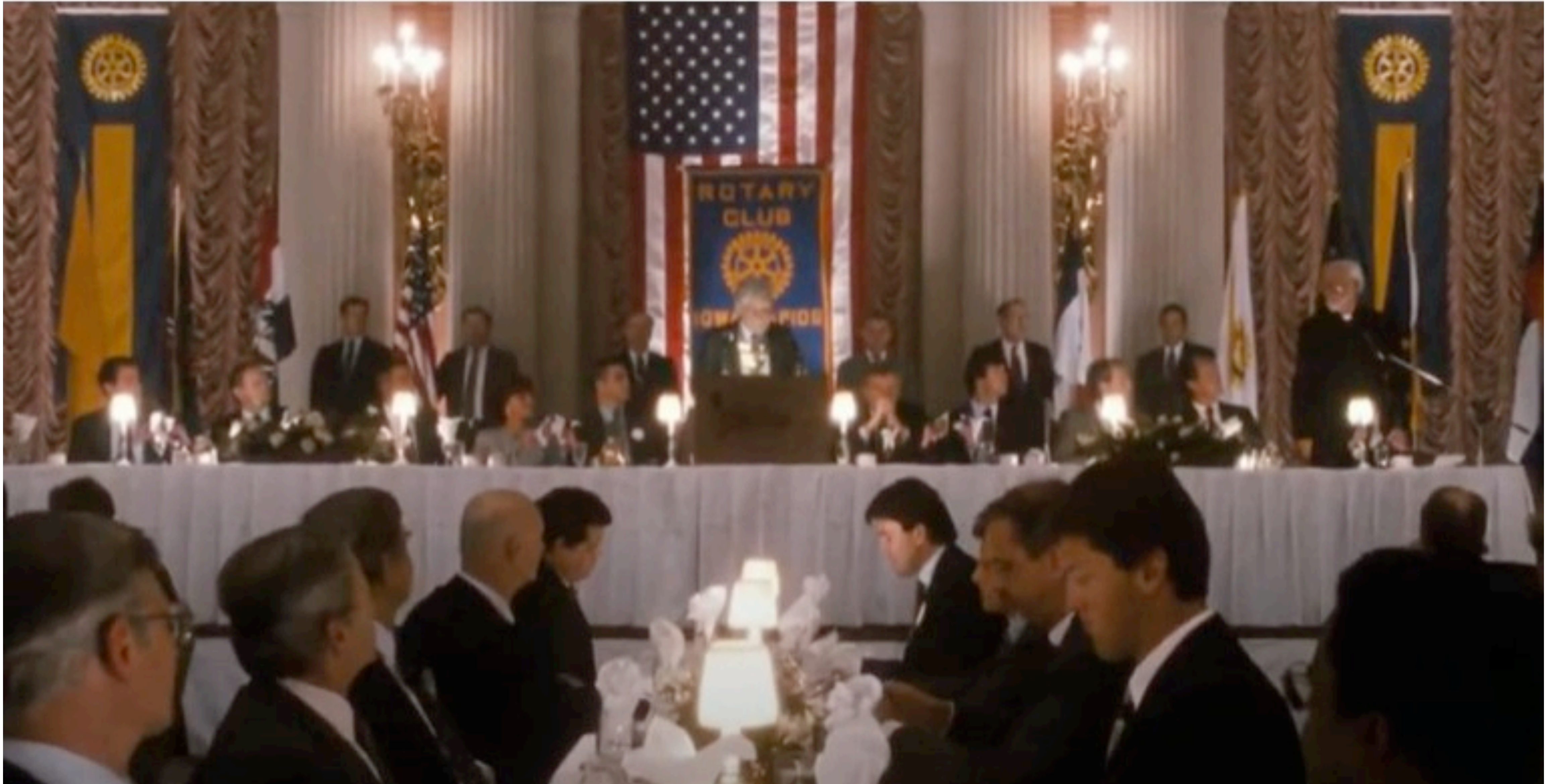

# Answer 1.

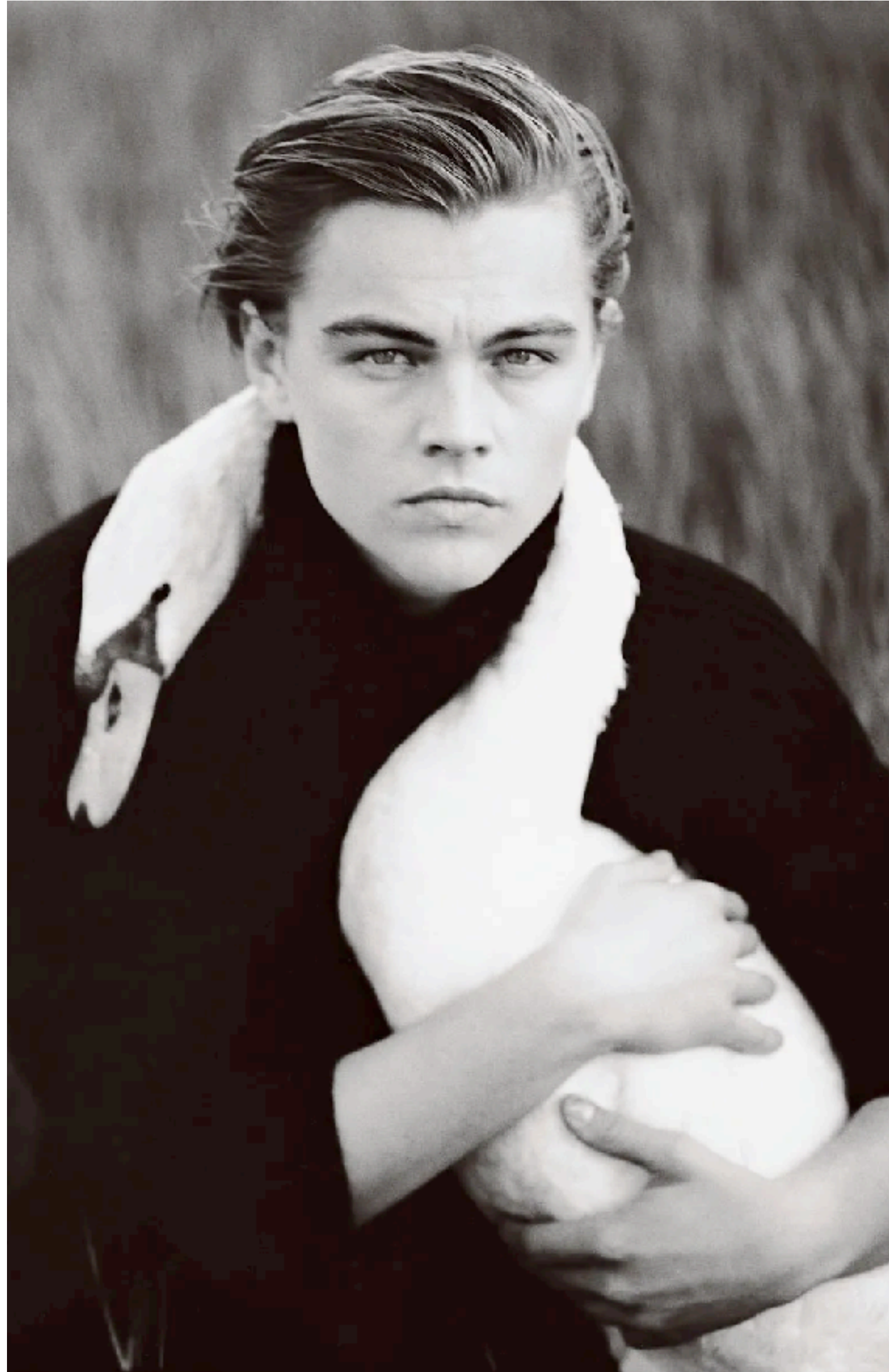
